DGCA - MiC promotes the creation, production, distribution and circulation of film and audiovisual works, the professional training, the opening and modernisation of cinemas and the adaptation of technical industries to technological developments.

To support the industry DGCA - MiC manages the national film fund that amounts to an annual minimum budget of 750 million \in .

DGCA - MiC represents Italy before EU, the Council of Europe, other international bodies and international funds that issue supranational support to the sector (Creative Europe – MEDIA sub-programme, Eurimages, Ibermedia).

It also manages bilateral funds with similar institutions in other countries to sustain the development of international co-productions.

DGCA - MiC supports Cinecittà, the Fondazione La Biennale di Venezia, the Centro Sperimentale di Cinematografia, the Museo nazionale del Cinema Fondazione Maria Adriana Prolo-Archivi di fotografia, cinema ed immagine, the Fondazione Cineteca di Bologna, the Cineteca italiana di Milano and the Cineteca del Friuli di Gemona del Friuli.

Among their films we can remember: Legions of the Nile, The Rebellion of the Gladiators, The Giants of Thessaly, Kingdom of Violence, Tedeum, War Goddess, Les Biches, L'epé du Cid, L'Harem, Les Grandes Gueules and many more.

Alexandra is a company associated in APA (www.apaonline.it) and Unindustria (Confindustria - www.un-industria.it).

In 2019 Alexandra produced *Butterflies in Berlin*, directed by Monica Manganelli, in co-production with Germany, and with Rai Cinema, and participates in over 300 festivals around the world, got the selection in the final stages of 60 of them and won 29 including gets a special mention at the Tel Aviv Film Festival in June 2019 and the Selection letter by Oscar Academy.

In 2021 we have produced a new movie, *Mum I am the Boss*, directed by Federico Moccia coming soon in Italian and Spanish Cinemas. In 2022 Alexandra produced *The Cookfather – Estomago II*, an international co-production movie with Brazil and Warner Bros Distributing inc., at cinemas in 2024.

Alexandra is now developing a TV series for RAi Fiction – Radio Televisione Italiana - with a team of authors led by Salvatore De Mola, that will be shot in 2024.

In 2023 the company has in post-production other three important Italian TV series.
